

LEARN TO SEW:

EASY TABLE RUNNER

9 in. x 21 in.



MATERIAL REQUIREMENTS

| | |
|--------------|--------------------------|
| | Table Runner |
| | 9 in. x 21 in. |
| Print/Solids | (2) 3.5 in. squares |
| Backing | 1/3 yard |
| Binding | (2) 2.5 in. x WOF strips |
| Batting | 17 in. x 29 in. |

- » Please read through all instructions before beginning.
- » WOF means width of fabric.
- » RST means right sides together.
- » HST means half-square triangle.
- » This pattern assumes all WOF are 42" and unwashed.
- » All seam allowances are 1/4".

ASSEMBLING YOUR RUNNER

Start assembling your table runner by sewing together (3) 3.5 in. squares as shown below. Make (7) rows of (3) 3.5 in. squares.



Next, sew the rows together, pinning at each seam. When pinning, allow seams to nest by pressing one row's seams left, and the next row's seams right. Once all rows have been sewn together, iron seams. Quilt and bind as desired! Find a binding tutorial on Yellowumbrellaquilts.com.
